## INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- 1) The poster size must be as close as possible to 90 cm in width x 120-140 cm in height.
- 2) Posters will be displayed in the **Poster Area.** Poster Printing is under the responsibility of the authors. You need to print the posters, bring them to congress center and hang to dedicated poster board.

We have an agreement with a printing office in Copenhagen, DEGN GRAFISK.

If you don't want to carry your printed poster, you can click <a href="https://apimondia.degngrafisk.dk/login">https://apimondia.degngrafisk.dk/login</a>, create an account for you, upload your design ready to be printed, pay the printing&delivery fee and have your poster delivered to Congress Center.

- 3) Each poster will be **displayed for 2 days continuously** according to the following program (Bee Health and Technology and Quality of bee Products during 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of September), while posters for B-RAP, Bee Biology, Pollination and Bee Flora, Beekeeping Economy, Rural Development and Apitherapy will be presented during 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2025.
- 4) Authors are invited to stand by their poster during the lunch break (13.00 14.30) for possible questions by Congress delegates.
- 5) Each poster will be assigned a **number** and must be hung on the display board marked with the same number. Poster numbers will be indicated in the Final Program Book.
- 6) The necessary accessories for hanging the poster will be supplied by the volunteers who will be available in the Poster Area from 08.00
- 7) The poster must be hung between **08.00 09.00** of the morning the day of the Poster Presentation and displayed for the duration of 2 days (as indicated above). Poster are to be removed between **18.00 –19.00**, after their allocated 2 days
- 8) Authors must strictly respect the above-mentioned timing for hanging and removing posters. Posters not removed by the scheduled time will be removed by the Organizing Secretariat and disposed of. The Organizing Secretariat is not responsible for lost posters.
- 9) If the presenting author of the poster is not registered to congress or not informed the Congress Secretariat about his/her participation, presentation will be removed from the program.
- 10) Pdfs of the poster are requested to be uploaded to <a href="https://apimondia.easyevents.io/eposter/by">https://apimondia.easyevents.io/eposter/by</a> August 22nd, to be ready for evaluation (students' posters) and be uploaded in the Apimondia's webpage/ Cloud and the abstract book. If not, the abstract will be in the abstract book instead of the finalised poster.













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11) **Students' posters should have an indication** on the poster and on the pdf as a committee composed by each Scientific Commission will evaluate them and select the **best student poster per scientific commission**. The winners will be given a special recognition during the Closing Ceremony on 27<sup>th</sup> September.

## Criteria for the best Student's Posters

- a. Title: Easy to read, captured the idea/topic of the poster
- b. Written Material: Introduction/ methodology/ results/ conclusions/. Wording should be limited, clear, easy to follow, easy to read from 1' away, and accurate
- **c. Layout/Design:** Space used effectively. Graphics and writing are not crowded and the layout is easy to follow
- d. Creativity: Graphics/Pictures/Illustrations: They enhance poster's impact or message and help the viewer to understand the content
- e. Overall Impression: Poster attracting attention and conveying a message to the beekeepers
